The meeting was called to order at approximately 7:15 pm. The Citizens' Committee considered the following matters:

Financial Report: The Town's finances remain in good condition. Ase Sewall will present the annual financial report and budget at the Annual Meeting on April 24, 2012.

Daley Lane: The Town continues to await word concerning whether the Town will receive the "Green Streets" grant applied for on March 9, 2012. If awarded, the grant would fund a portion of the proposed Daley Lane pervious pavement improvements. The Daley Lane improvements project will be on the agenda for the Annual Meeting scheduled for Tuesday, April 24, 2012 at 7:30 pm at the Ayr lawn YMCA facility at the end of Oakmont Avenue.

Building Permits: The Committee is still investigating an appropriate Building Permit that can be displayed at building sites along with the Montgomery County Building Permit after approval of the Oakmont Building Permit Application.

BRAC/NIH: Work on intersections has started.

Suburban Hospital: No news. The hospital has submitted its site plan applications to the Montgomery County Planning Board for approval for the proposed expansion.

Annual Meeting: The Annual Town Meeting will be held on Tuesday, April 24, 2012. The Committee plans to distribute another flyer with the information and to send another email to the Town email list. The Committee discussed nominations for a new Committee member to replace Ella Iams.

Website: The Committee continues to consider options for improving the Town website.

Next Meeting: The next Oakmont Committee meeting will be held in May, time and date to be determined.
