Suburban Hospital has submitted the expansion plan. She spoke for Oakmont at the last Bethesda-Chevy Chase meeting voicing our support of the plan.

NIH is building an integrated research facility at Ft. Detrick. Ft. Detrick employees infected would be transferred to NIH in Bethesda where they could be isolated for treatment.

Montgomery County is one of the few counties not charging an ambulance fee. The rescue workers are against the fee, because some residents would be hesitant to call an ambulance.
