Daley Lane and garden restoration: Chair gathered 5 proposals; garden committee met and found prices were roughly at par. Identified American Plant and Mark Willcher as top candidates. Anna, Donna, and Kathy met with Willcher last Saturday to walk the site. Maintenance contract would run 4 x per year. Willcher also recommended using a snowblower rather than a plow to avoid further disturbance to the gravel. Committee agreed to go forward with Willcher's estimate. Chair will ask him to send complete contract.

Building permit for 5615 Oak Place and Doug Lohmeyer's report on review of bulding plans: Doug Lohmeyer has reported on the proposed construction at 5615 and the wall check at 5610. Two main issues at 5615 are water collection and the bumpout on the side of the house.

Financial report: Town is solvent; can afford bills and planned Daley Lane project.

Picnic planning update: Backyard Inflatables plans to come and pick up tables etc. at 9:00 pm. Committee agreed to ask for them to stay a little later since the picnic is a Saturday night – maybe 9:30 or 10:00.

Liaison Report: No recent meetings to report. Will inquire with Pepco about the work they appear to be doing at Oakmont and Old Georgetown. Suburban Hospital plans to begin their work next Summer.

Miscellaneous: Rescue Squad has approached the town to request a donation. Town typically donates \$500 annually around Christmas. Chair has invited Rescue Squad to visit the picnic.
