Pat Mazuzan

Marilyn reported construction may begin in July at National Naval Medical Center and no funding has been improved for road improvements.

Bethesda Town Meeting will be held June 11<sup>th</sup> at Pyle Middle School and in the meeting Suburban Hospital is seeking approval for its expansion. Pat and Marilyn Mazuzan will attend the meeting. Suburban wants to take down the parking garage and expand the medical offices in addition to building a green area as a buffer between the hospital and the residential area. The houses impacted by the expansion are owned by the hospital.

Irwin Faibisch

Barbara believes the concrete project is complete and the contractor has been paid. Pat will check on the broken water main cap with the contractor.

- Search for bench options for Eleanor Dillon. It was recommended a redwood or type of bench that will last a long time.

New Business:

-Barbara proposed Oakmont will support both bills pending at Montgomery County listed below:

ZTA 08-11 Reduce the current foot print on a house on a lot.

- Require 30 days notices for neighbors to send input on new construction.

The purpose of these bills is to develop reasonable standards to work with the communities.
