The meeting was called to order at approximately 7:15 pm. The Board considered the following matters:

Follow-up on Daley Lane:

Landscaping: The Board discussed establishing landscaping that is less maintenance-intensive. Marilyn will contact Mr. Sorto, the current landscaper, for maintenance work and his landscaping suggestions. Donna will invite town citizens who live near Daley Lane to join a subcommittee for landscaping.

Driveway Project: The Board briefly discussed the implications for the Green Alley project, now that the town did not receive the Chesapeake Bay Trust grant. Donna will contact CH2M HILL, who will prepare the documents required for the bid proposal, to find out about the next steps, as well as Doug Lohmeyer to ask whether he will be available to supervise the project.

Parking Permits: Irwin and Fran Faibish asked that town citizens who need permanent and/or temporary (guest) permits contact them by phone at: 301-530-6963 before picking up the stickers at their house.

Fall Picnic Committee: Several town citizens have agreed to participate in the committee for the fall picnic, which will take place on the Saturday after Labor Day (September 8, 2012). However, additional participants are still needed.

Follow-up on permit sticker: The Board briefly discussed the Oakmont permit stickers to be displayed with the county building permit at the building site. Ingrid will bring some design suggestions to the next meeting.

Ingrid's swearing in: Donna and Marilyn will get the letters ready for Ingrid's swearing in.

Liaison Report: Marilyn reported that there was no news on the Suburban Hospital expansion project. She will continue attending the upcoming meetings with NIH, who are working on a new plan for the campus.
