Minutes of November 15, 2010 Meeting

Financial Report-There was none.

Parking Report- There was none.

Suburban Hospital- Montgomery County Zoning Appeals Board approved the expansion of the hospital with some modifications. The local citizen's association is deciding how to react.

BRAC- There is discussion not to disband BRAC. The neighborhoods want it to continue because decisions have not been made and the impact will be large.

NIH- Cars are not allowed entry at Old Georgetown Road and Lincoln because it is now a construction entrance.

Other

Trees: An estimate will be sought from Davey to compare with the one from Arbor Care for the work that Arbor Care recommended needed to be done.

Gary Jacobs: Gary will be notified that he can have Davey Tree Service perform the work on his property and he can pay and be reimbursed or have the Citizens Committee pay Davey directly.

Leaf Collection: Bethke does the leaf collection for Oakmont. They have billed us for the first of two pickups. Before we pay, we will check to see if Montgomery County collects leaves only on Oakmont or on both Oakmont and Oak Place. If the County government performs leaf collection on Oakmont only, we have to renegotiate our contract to do leaf collection for Oak Place only. The County cleared leaves on Oakmont on November 17. The county did not clear leaves on Oak Place.

Side Walks and Daley Lane: Two estimates have been received and we need one more before a contract is let.

Directory: The Directory is completed and will be distributed to all the residents of the town.

SHA: There is a form that has to be submitted to the SHA. It includes information that we give regarding snow plowing and tree work. Mike will find and complete the form

Electric Lines- We talked about whether to pursue seeking estimates for underground power lines but also mentioned that once the lines are underground, there are problems when power is lost and that can happen. The light on Daly Lane is out and has to be looked at to determine if the bulb is burned out or there is a problem. Mike will look into that.

Volunteer Welcoming Committee – Ella will call the Anna Shah 301-530-2301 since she has volunteered to be hospitality chair. I will describe the responsibilities of the position.
