1. Financial Report: Committee reviewed balance amount and net gain since 4/30/13; finances are in good shape.
2. Building permit for 5615 Oak Place. Re: Doug Lohmeyer's final question and response from builder: dual sump pump discharge for basement will go to curb. Chair drafted letter to builder stating town has no objection to continuing with plans.
3. McNamara garage permit: submitted an application to replace existing garage with a 1.5-story structure. Owners to show plans to opposite and adjacent neighbors.
4. Daley lane update: town entered into contract with Mark Willcher.
5. Website bulletin board and resident directory: bulletin board is working. Residents will need to register using the email account listed for them on the directory.
6. Liaison report: Navy will destroy 5 buildings behind the historic tower and replace them with a new building. Also adding a new building to the USUS facility in back. SHA reports that 355 Cedar Lane intersection work is delayed due to utilities work; expecting to finish this Fall. June-August 2014 is tentative time to close Cedar Lane to the East of 355. Contractors will be selected Spring of 2014. Discussed notifying SHA contacts that the Oakmont sign will need to be moved appropriately when construction on Old Georgetown occurs.
7. Miscellaneous – Committee discussed making a donation to BCC Rescue Squad; will continue discussion at next meeting.
